What information do we collect?



We collect information about you. This includes:





- The person we should contact if anything happens to you
- The name of your local doctor



Details of visits to the hospital



Test results and x-rays



 Information from other NHS professionals who care for you



We may keep this information in writing or on a computer.

How the Trust uses your information



We will use your information when our staff:

 Look at your health needs and give you the care and treatment you need



Refer you to a different health service



 Look after you while you are in hospital



Check the quality of your care




Investigate any problems with your care

The Trust may use and share some of your information to help us:





 Check that the NHS is giving a good service



 Give information to the government about our work



Look into new ways of caring for people



 Make sure our services can meet patient needs in the future



Teach and train healthcare professionals

Do we share information about you with anyone?



There are times when it is right for us to share information about you with other people and organisations.



We may share your information with:

Local doctors (GPs)



 Health Authorities, NHS Trusts, NHS England



 The Government's Department of Health



 The local Council's Social Services and Education Services



Private health and care companies with your consent



 Community organisations that provide care services with your consent



We will not give your information to other people without your permission unless:



 Someone's health or safety is at risk



The law says we should



The law says that any other organisation that gets information from this Trust must keep it safe.

Your rights



The law says that everyone working for the NHS has to keep information about you safe and confidential.



You have the right to have your personal information kept safe and secure.



You have the right to be told about how your information is being used.



You have the right to ask for a copy of your medical records.



You have the right to ask that your personal information is only used for your own care and treatment.



You have the right to check that your information is correct and up to date.

Keep your records safe and secure



 Give you information in a way that you can understand



 Give you a copy of your records when you ask for them

If you want a copy of your records you should:

You will need to give us:

Your name, address, date of birth



 2 proofs of who you are: copies of your passport, driving licence, letter from your bank, bills



We will send you copies of your records by email.



If you are asking for someone else's information, you will need to give us a letter from them with copies of their proof of identity


