What to expect after CT Colonography Information for Bowel Cancer Screening Patients

What are the possible after-effects of the procedure?

You may experience some mild/moderate windy pains in your stomach. This is most likely to be due to the gas put in by the endoscopist during your examination. This is normal and the pain should ease within 24 hours.

Results

The x-ray department may advise you that you will get the result from your GP. However, your specialist screening practitioner will be aware of when you are having the test and will contact you directly to explain the results once they are available. This is usually within 1 working week of the date of your test.
