Membership

- Membership of the Health Sciences Library is freely available to **all** NHS staff working within the local health economy and healthcare students on placement.
- The library is staffed 9am to 5pm, Monday to Friday
- 24 hour access is available to all staff with FPH Trust ID badges

KnowledgeShare

Sign up to KnowledgeShare to receive targeted updates on your professional interests. KnowledgeShare updates focus on the evidence that can change practice, and the latest publications on quality, safety, education and patient experiences. Registration forms are available from the library or online via our website. **Please note an active OpenAthens account is required to view articles and update your preferences.**

Books & Borrowing

The library is multidisciplinary and currently has a book stock of over 5000 items, arranged in subject order.

- Up to 8 books may be borrowed at any one time (max 2 short loan items).
- Loan periods are 2 weeks for short loans and 4 weeks for items from our main collection.
- A limited number of renewals can be made.
- Fines are levied for late returns.
- A books returns box is located outside the main library entrance
- There is a **self-issue kiosk** for borrowing, renewing and returning your books 24/7.

Inter-Library Loans

Any book or journal article that is not held locally, or available to download, can be ordered from other locations. Request forms can be obtained from the library or requests can be made online via our website. **Please note this service is not available to students on placement.**

Southeast Library Search

On request, a member of the library team will issue you with a unique PIN which, together with your Library ID number, will enable you to access information about your current loans, make renewals and request books, etc. online via www.southeastlibrarysearch.nhs.uk. You can also access the regional library catalogue at this address.

Healthy Living & Fiction Collections

The library also has a Healthy Living collection of books and DVDs covering all aspects of health and fitness, as well as a number of fiction titles. These are available to all library members.
