There are also a number of supporting strategies, based on our priorities, that focus on how we support our people, develop our buildings, and manage our money for example.

Our strategy is flexible, allowing us to adapt to any changing circumstances. We will report regularly to the Board of Directors and Council of Governors, who will monitor and review our progress and this will be communicated widely. We will also ensure that there continues to be a variety of ways that we can listen to and seek input from our patients, staff, members, partners and local communities.
