

Standardised Patient Job Description

General Responsibility

The Standardised Patient reports directly to the QuEST Simulation Team and the Clinical Faculty of the simulation session. This position is to portray all the characteristics of a real patient where possible and to simulate the signs and symptoms of the patient's condition. Standardised patients will often be physically examined by students and faculty as part of the candidates learning experience.

Specific Tasks

- Be highly dependable and punctual
- Demonstrate flexibility and reliability with scheduling and assignments
- Follow written and verbal instruction
- Provide constructive feedback to candidates and colleagues
- Work in a professional manner when interacting with learners, faculty, supervisors and peers
- Be comfortable having repeated physical examination manoeuvres performed
- Be willing to wear a hospital gown with only undergarments underneath, while on camera and/or observed live through an observation window or video monitor
- Simulate all aspects of scenarios, including history of current problem, affect/behaviour and physical findings, in a standardized, accurate and reliable manner
- Accurately and consistently complete checklists
- Accept feedback from facilitators and incorporate it into simulation
- Be willing to be filmed and photographed during simulations, which may occasionally be used for social media and publicising the service.
- Other duties as assigned
